# Schools

New York is renowned for its public schools. In 2020, Cooperstown Public Schools were ranked #32 out of 430 districts in Upstate New York. Cooperstown has average class sizes well under 20 students, and a district-wide student-to-teacher ratio of 14 to 1. Cooperstown has a higher graduation rate and more regents/advanced regents diplomas awarded than the New York State average. BOCES classes are available, as well as AP classes.

Cooperstown graduates are highly desired by the nation's top colleges, and recent graduates have attended Ivy Leagues, NESCAC schools, US Military Academies, as well as many other prestigious institutions.

Graduates from Cooperstown and other local districts, including BOCES, are eligible to receive Clark Foundation Scholarships. These scholarships can be used for traditional 4-year colleges, certificate programs, and associate degrees, and can continue for graduate studies in health care-related fields.

# FAQ

### Can I live in rural upstate New York?

Cooperstown is much more than baseball. We delight in our many lakes including Otsego, Goodyear, and Canadarago. Did you know Otsego Lake is the beginning of the Susquehanna River, which is the longest river on the east coast of the United States? We have beautiful hikeable rolling hills and state parks. We are medical professionals, farmers, artists, musicians, gardeners, crafters, writers, readers, athletes, animal lovers, entrepreneurs, teachers, environmental stewards, and much more.

We are a caring and friendly community with a multitude of opportunities. You may enjoy the slower pace of life, admire our beautiful surroundings, or fill your days with many activities.

Cooperstown is located so centrally in New York that one can get to every corner in about four hours. Destinations include the wonderful Corning Museum of Glass; astounding waterfalls from Ithaca to Niagara; horse-racing mecca Saratoga Springs; Olympic Village Lake Placid, wine country Finger Lakes; the Catskill and Adirondack Mountains and their small historic villages; and of course New York City and its suburbs. Boston, Philadelphia, Toronto and Montreal are also within a half day's drive.

### Summer's great but what am I going to do in the winter?

Many people look forward to fun outdoor pursuits in winter including cross country skiing, snowshoeing, sledding, ice fishing, outdoor hockey, ice skating, snowman making, and Winter Carnival. Others are happy to pursue old hobbies or develop new skills. There is indoor tennis and pickleball. Clark Sports Center hosts a bevy of leagues including dodgeball, basketball, futsal, and volleyball. Enjoy seasonal concerts, movie nights, traditional Thanksgiving and Christmas celebrations. You may find cooking classes; knitting/weaving/spinning instruction, pottery and art classes; master gardener classes; enjoy mahjong, bridge, scrabble and other games; join a book club; engage with other quilters, take courses in home improvement; take an adult education course at BOCES; and volunteer.

#### Can I get coffee from Starbucks? Where can I shop?

Oneonta has a Starbucks, but Cooperstown offers unique bistros like Stagecoach Coffee, where coffee beans are roasted on site. The Cooperstown Farmer's Market is open year round. In addition to local produce there are cheeses, maple and honey products, jellies/jams, bakery items, fiber, pottery, and glass. We have Cooperstown Natural Food for organic needs. Cooperstown Cheese Company has a variety of artisanal cheeses and is part of CNY (Central New York) Cheese Trail. The Fly Creek Cider Mill is an historic, water-powered cider mill on the banks of Fly Creek pressing fresh, sweet cider for 167 years. Experience the Fly Creek Cider Mill's Marketplace with over 150 specialty foods including fresh fudge, aged cheddar cheese, salsas, apple wines and hard cider. Enjoy coffee and pastries at Mohican Market at the Otesaga Resort Hotel.

Cooperstown has local clothing, art, craft and of course baseball shops. Close to Cooperstown is Bouckville, a village dedicated to antique shops and Hobart with eight independent used book shops. Closest to home is Price Chopper and Grand Union supermarkets. Oneonta has Hannafords, Price Chopper, Aldi's, Walmart, and BJs.

More high end markets and ethnic groceries can be found in Utica, New Hartford, Albany, Binghamton, and Syracuse. Indoor malls are found in New Hartford, Albany, and Binghamton or make a day of it in Syracuse for Destiny USA, which hosts over 250 places to shop, dine and play.

### I am single; where do I meet people?

People of all ages participate in athletics and sport leagues; join classes/clubs, volunteer in a multitude of areas, and engage in social activities. In addition to the numerous restaurants that host live music there are musical and film events that cover all genres and will satisfy even the most discriminating tastes. We have breweries including Brewery Ommegang, Red Shed Brewery, Council Rock Brewery, Cooperstown Brewing Company. Cooperstown Distillery boasts handcrafted artisanal spirits many of which have won national awards!

### I have children; what activities are available for them?

Both The Farmer's Museum and Fenimore Art Museum provide wonderful attractions for children and adults. Our library has a dedicated children's section with many programs geared to them. Clark Sports Center has a toddler open gym time and sports activities/after-school programs/summer camps for school aged children. Cooperstown Central school is K - 12 with BOCES (Board of Cooperative Educational Services). This program is both for students wanting to start a vocation immediately upon graduation and those going on the upper level education. For younger children there are options for preschool and daycare.

### Can my spouse/partner find employment?

Working from home is frequently an option. In addition to healthcare there are jobs supporting the hospital system. Professional opportunities are available locally and in the surrounding areas. Within about a one hour radius there are multiple colleges and universities including: SUNY (State University of New York) Oneonta, SUNY Delhi, SUNY Cobleskill, SUNY Polytechnic Institute, Hartwick College, Hamilton College, and Colgate University. In addition to the local Fenimore Art Museum, The Farmer's Museum, and Baseball Hall of Fame, there is Munson Museum in Utica, and Arkel in Canajoharie. Retailers and contractors are always looking for workers.

#### Is there support for seniors or senior services?

There are activities geared toward seniors including programs at Clark Sports Center. Woodside Hall provides residential and day services. The Thanksgiving Home provides a secure environment for independent living. Heritage at the Plains at Parish Homestead in Oneonta offers independent and assisted living accommodations. There are skilled nursing facilities in Cooperstown, Oneonta, and surrounding areas. And of course there are quality medical services through the Bassett Healthcare Network.
